Here is a snapshot of what they told us!



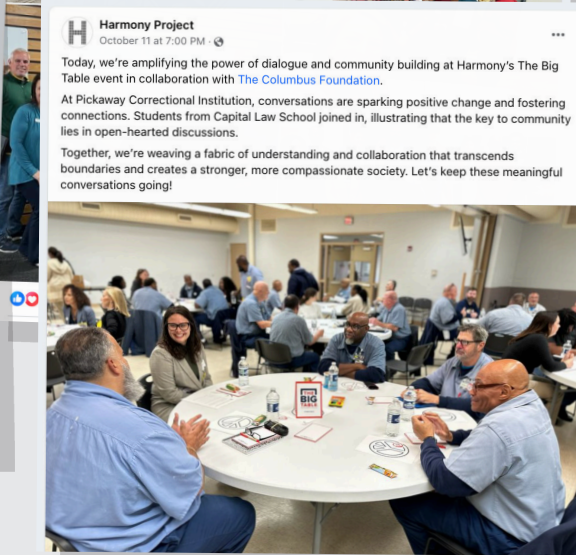
## CONVERSATION TOPICS
